**Relevance of the research issue:** During the developing of human societies in the last decade, there took place a lot of problems of planetary scale. These problems can not only influence our society but also be a threat to all human beings. The processes of globalization and integration in the region have led humanity to the realization that serious problems in the economic, environmental and other areas, resulting in some regions of the earth, will inevitably affect the condition of the entire planet. A system of closely interrelated threats such as environmental, energy, terrorism, that need to be solved by combining political, economic, scientific and technical capabilities of all the states. Russia in this process plays an important role as the country with the greatest resource potential. Russia - one of the first states in the international arena, which started the process of resolving many of today's global problems through bilateral and multilateral agreements and within the framework of international organizations.

However, at present the Western countries spend enough hard-line policy toward Russia, limiting its potential in addressing the global problems of today within the framework of international cooperation. In such circumstances, Russia's cooperation with the Western world on the settlement of global threats is being questioned in the short term. Nevertheless, this fact opens up new opportunities for Russia's participation in the programs of other international areas, including in the framework of multilateral cooperation with the BRICS countries.
